

## **RULES FOR ISLAND PARK CAMPGROUND**

Approved by Adel Park Board, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2009

Welcome to Island Park Campground. To enhance your enjoyment and those of the other campers, we ask you to please abide by the following rules and regulations.

1. Camping permitted only in described areas or designated by the Park Manager or the City of Adel. If a concrete pad is available campers must be parked on the pad.
2. No pets shall be allowed to run at large. All pets in the campground shall be kept on a leash not to exceed 6 feet in length. Pets must be kept quiet and are not to be tied to trees, water hydrants, electric boxes, etc. City Animal Ordinance will be enforced.
3. One table per campsite. Tables are not to be taken from other camp sites or City Parks.
4. Registered campers only from 10:00 P.M. to 7:00 A.M. The gate will be closed and quiet time begins at 10:00 P.M.
5. Fires in designated fire pits. Burning of roundwood only (no pallets, lumber with nails, or other construction debris). Only a two (2) week supply of wood allowed per campsite.
6. No dishwashing allowed in the bathhouse. Hot water is not to be taken from the bathhouse for personal use.
7. All garbage must be wrapped in paper or put in a plastic bag and placed in refuse containers. No burning of garbage anywhere.
8. No more than two (2) vehicles per campsite. All others must be in designated visitors parking. No parking in empty sites.
9. Parents will be held responsible for their children.
10. No loitering at the bathhouse or shelter house after 10:00 P.M.
11. No water fights, washing of cars or trailers.
12. No swimming in the river.
13. No recreational vehicles such as, but not limited to: ATV's, dirt or mini bikes, or go-carts. Recreational vehicles needed for a disability or ailment may be used with special permission from the City of Adel.
14. No beer kegs allowed.
15. No dumping of wastewater (including gray water) on the ground.
16. Campsites must be kept in a clean and orderly manner, as determined by the manger.
17. No repairing of vehicles in the campground. (City Junk Vehicle Ordinance will be enforced.)
18. No more than one (1) camping unit (camper or tent) per campsite. A unit may consist of a tent in addition to camper, at the discretion of the manager. The intent of this rule is to allow a small tent to be placed next to the camper for children to sleep, NOT for two families to share a campsite.
19. Only one electric cooler (small size) per campsite may be placed outside your camper. There will be a charge of \$2 per week or \$8 per month for this privilege.
20. No driving on grass except for parks department employees.
21. No fireworks or firearms allowed at any time.

The City reserves the right to refuse camping privileges to patrons who violate the above rules or who create disruptions for the other campers. Rain checks and refunds are not given.
