The Official "I HAVE A BASEMENT AGAIN!" Day!

(NOTE: This cleanup is for residential only - no business, apartment complexes or trailer parks)

As a part of your monthly residential garbage fee, Ankeny Sanitation offers an annual designated "Spring Cleanup" day to pick up unwanted items (e.g., davenports, chairs, bikes, mattresses, etc.) on the curb. All items will be hauled to the South Dallas County Landfill.

Collection will begin at **7:00 a.m.**, so please get your items out before then. Getting your unwanted "junk" out the day before will allow the "recyclers" to have a chance.

- **NO LIQUIDS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

Latex paint must be either dried out or soaked with kitty litter or saw dust. Place cans out in plain sight with lids OFF so the hauler will know that cans do not contain liquid. (For hazardous liquids, including oil based paints, see the other side of this flyer.)

- **TIRES:** Two (2) tires per household may be set out on the curb.

- **NONE OF THE FOLLOWING:** Car Batteries, concrete, propane gas cylinders

- **CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS:** Must be bundled in 4 foot lengths, weighing no more than 50 lbs., and **NO NAILS!**

- **APPLIANCE STICKERS.**

There is a \$10.00 fee per appliance. **Anyone having any of the following items to dispose of MUST purchase a sticker from Adel City Hall for pick-up:**

refrigerators	freezers	washers	dryers
stoves/ovens	furnaces	heaters	computer monitors
dishwashers	microwaves	water heaters	humidifiers

TV's (1 STICKER FOR 30" OR LESS; 2 STICKERS FOR ALL OVER 30")

Appliances without stickers will not be picked up!

Appliance Stickers may be purchased at City Hall, 8:30 a.m.—4:30 p.m., Mon.-Fri.

For the 21st year, the **ADEL LIONS CLUB** will be the "**Cleanup Crew**" at Adel's Kinnick-Feller Park, collecting your old unused chemicals and household hazardous materials **free of charge**. These hazardous materials will be transported to the Regional Collection Center in Bondurant for proper disposal. Items to be collected include:

Paint remover, thinner	Stain & varnish	Oil based caulk	Fluorescent tubes
Metal polish	Gas & kerosene	Cell phones	Rechargeable batteries
Rust remover	Mercury switches	Pesticides	CFL bulbs
Tar, oil based adhesives	Oil based paint	Oil filters	Glue & contact cement
Drain & oven cleaners	Pool chemicals	Weed killers, fertilizers	Mercury thermostats
Ammonia cleaners	Aerosol cleaners	Anti-freeze	Sharps

ALSO: This year along with the used motor oil, the OIL CONTAINERS will be collected to be recycled at the Bondurant facility. Car and lawn mower batteries will also be collected for recycling.
NO TVs or MONITORS.

ACREAGES, SMALL FARM OWNERS, and BUSINESSES:
You may be able to dispose of chemicals at the Regional Collection Center. For details, call 1-888-603-2739.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:
Ammunition, explosives, fire extinguishers, compressed gas cylinders, asbestos ...
and NO LATEX PAINT.
