

ORDINANCE NO. 330

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 91.10 & 99.15 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ADEL FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVISING THE WATER DEDUCT METER REQUIREMENTS

Be it enacted by the City Council of the City of Adel, Iowa:

SECTION 1. TEXT AMENDMENTS. The Adel Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by amending Section 91.10, Deduct Water Meters, as follows:

“91.10 DEDUCT WATER METERS.

A deduct water meter may be installed to measure water that is not discharged into the sanitary sewer system. The deduct water meter must be purchased at City Hall at cost, plus \$25.00. Upon purchase it is the owner’s responsibility to install, maintain and replace the meter. Only meters purchased from and registered by the City will be allowed a sewer usage credit.

Effective September 11, 2018, the City shall only approve the usage of plumbed-in City deduct water meters. The approval of external hose bib deduct meters shall be discontinued. External hose bib deduct meters that have already been sold by the City may continue to be used by the property owner or customer only as long as the meter is brought to City Hall annually in October for inspection and application of the usage credit. Notwithstanding the foregoing, all external hose bib deduct meters shall be taken out of service on or before September 11, 2028.

Deduct water meters shall be approved and inspected by the City’s water department. The City shall not be liable for the defacement or damage of any property caused by necessary holes, fastenings or other work required for the installation of a deduct water meter, nor shall the City be liable for any damage to service lines or water system valves and equipment.”

SECTION 2. TEXT AMENDMENTS. The Adel Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by amending Section 91.15, Sewer Usage Credit, as follows:

“99.15 SEWER USAGE CREDIT.

A sewer usage credit shall be issued for water measured through a deduct meter installed per Section 91.10 of this Code of Ordinances.”

SECTION 3. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.


SECTION 5. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.


