Open Swim Procedures

Target Date: Monday, July 6th



Admission

- Start at 50% capacity (253) and increase when comfortable
- Pre-Registration
 - 60% of spots can be pre-registered online for afternoon session
 - When registration is confirmed, QR code will be sent via text or email. Patron must bring QR code to be scanned by staff at the admission desk to enter the pool.
 - No preregistration for evening session
 - Reservations can be made a week in advance starting every Friday at 8am
 - If aquatic center is closed due to weather, refunds will be given in a form of credit to an individuals account. No refunds will be given after 90 minutes have passed in a session
- Remaining spots will be first come, first served with a “one in, one out” policy
- No season passes or family day passes
- Daily admission of \$5 for afternoon session, \$3 for evening session
- Not limited to Adel residents as Kristine suggested to avoid this

Hours

- Normal operating hours
- 6:30-8:30am Adult Lap Swim (MWF only)
- 12:30-5pm Open Swim
- 5:00-6:00pm Family Swim and Adult Lap Swim
- 6:00-8:00pm Open Swim

Operations

- No deck chairs, patrons can bring in their own chairs
- Limited concessions (prepacked food only)
- Facilities cleaned between open swim sessions and throughout day as needed
 - Focus areas
 - Ladders and railings of diving boards and slide steps
 - Restrooms
 - Concession counter and tables
- Children 8 & younger need to be accompanied by an adult 16+
- No groups of more than 30 people (must pre-register by calling)
- Patrons encouraged to use hand sanitizer at front desk before entering facility
- Patrons encouraged to practice social distancing protocols by keeping 6 feet away from those not in their immediate household
- Patrons encouraged to arrive “swim ready”
- Social distancing guides will be marked in areas where lines may form (admissions, concessions, slides, diving boards, etc)
