

**Adel City Council
July 26, 2021 – Meeting Minutes**

The Adel City Council met in regular session at the Adel City Hall, 301 S. 10th Street, Adel, Iowa on Monday, July 26, 2021. At 6:00 p.m., Mayor Peters called the meeting to order. The following answered roll: Ockerman, McAdon, Miller, Selby, and Christensen.

- a) Consider Approval of Resolution No. 21-61, Ordering Construction of the Southbridge Lift Station Improvements, Lift Station Project, and Fixing a Date for Hearing Thereon and Taking of Bids Therefor

- b) Consider Approval of Resolution No. 21-62, Ordering Construction of the Southbridge Lift Station Improvements, Force Main Project, and Fixing a Date for Hearing Thereon and Taking of Bids Therefor
Motion by Ockerman, seconded by Miller, to approve Resolution No. 21-62.

OTHER BUSINESS

- a) Council Member McAdon reported that there had been a fire in the pile of mulch that is used for erosion control on top of a closed area at the South Dallas County Landfill. Landfill staff was able to douse the fire from the Landfill's water truck but the Fire Department assisted to provide more water. Landfill staff will continue to monitor the situation.
- b) City Administrator Brown reported that the City would receive approximately \$813,000 in funding from the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. The City will receive half of that amount in August 2021 and half a year later. McAdon noted that more research of the rules by staff will be necessary before decisions can be considered and public input sought. Selby suggested a public statement would be beneficial. Christensen reminded that federal Treasury guidance is needed before the City appropriates the funds.
